

Auspicious and Inauspicious Dates

These dates are the same every year. They occur in addition to the auspicious and inauspicious days that are specific to each year. Keep in mind that in the Lunar calendar system the day changes at noon mid-day, not midnight as in the Gregorian Solar calendar. This mid-day change may also occur not directly at noon, but can fluctuate between morning and afternoon.

February, May, August, and November

1, 7, 13, 19, 25, and 31- Auspicious dates to begin a journey

2, 8, 14, 20, and 26- Inauspicious to start a journey (known as Tashi Gachka)

3, 9, 15, 21, 27- Auspicious to travel for all purposes

4, 10, 16, 22, and 28- Safe to travel

5, 11, 17, 23, and 29- Inauspicious to travel, chances of loss

6, 12, 18, 24, and 30- Very auspicious to travel

March, June, September, and December (December is in general auspicious except where noted)

1, 9, 17, and 25- Inauspicious, heavy loss may occur

2, 10, 18, and 26- Auspicious to travel for all purposes

3, 11, 19, and 27- Good to travel for business

4, 12, 20, and 28- Good to travel for all purposes

5, 13, 21, and 29- Business likely to run loss

6, 14, 22, and 30- Any activity related to marriage will be successful

7, 15, 23, and 31- Troublesome for journey

8, 16, and 24- Auspicious to begin a journey

January, April, July, and October

1, 9, 17, and 25- Troubles likely to occur during business

2, 10, 18, and 26- Auspicious for journey to long distance

3, 11, 19, and 27- Journey to all directions auspicious

4, 12, 20, and 28- Avoid long distance journey

5, 13, 21, and 29- Inauspicious for travelling

6, 14, 22, and 30- Good chances of achievement in business

7, 15, 23, and 31- Auspicious to travel

8, 16, and 24- Business achievement not possible
